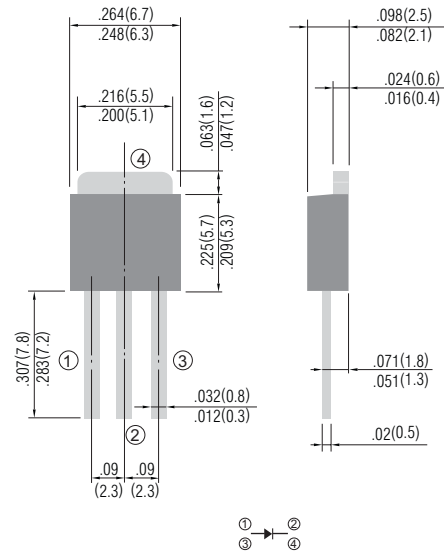

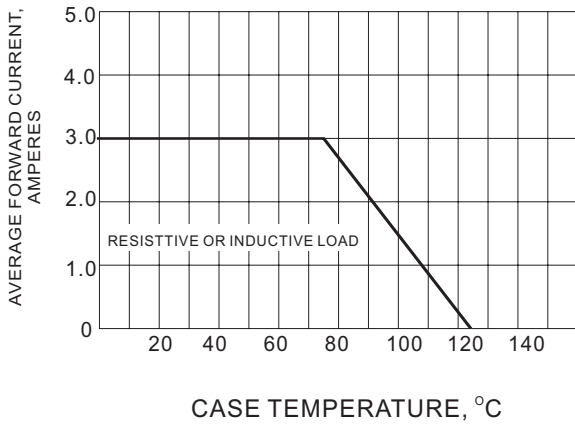

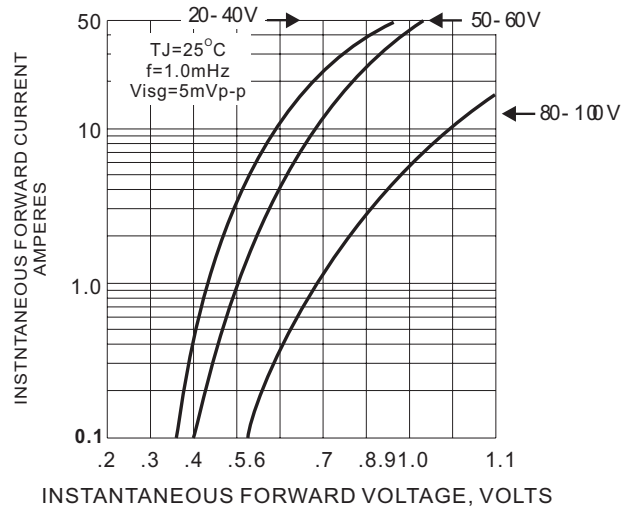

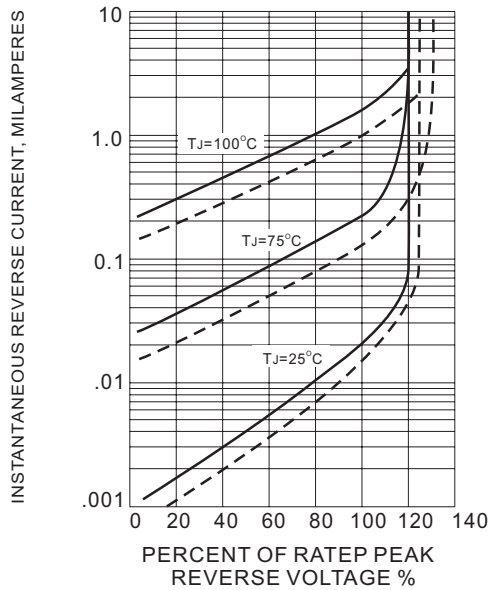

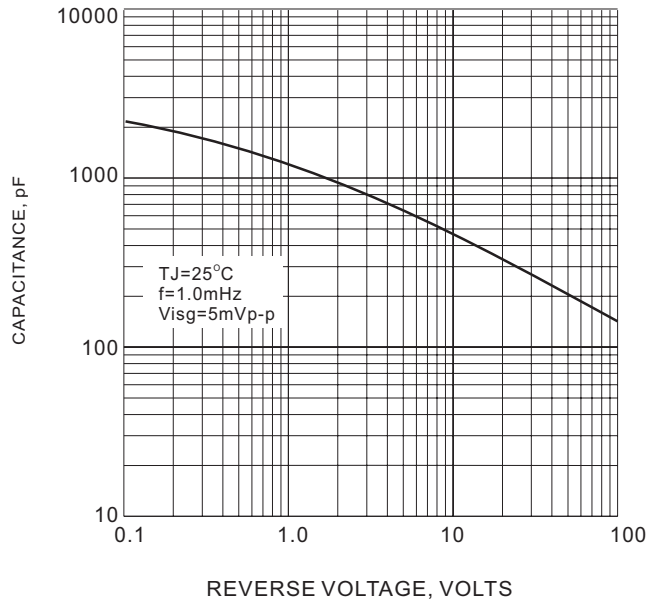
**Fig.1- FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE**



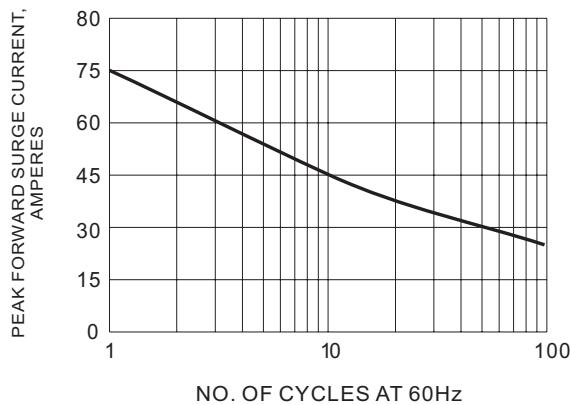
**Fig.2- TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTIC**
