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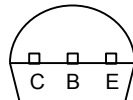

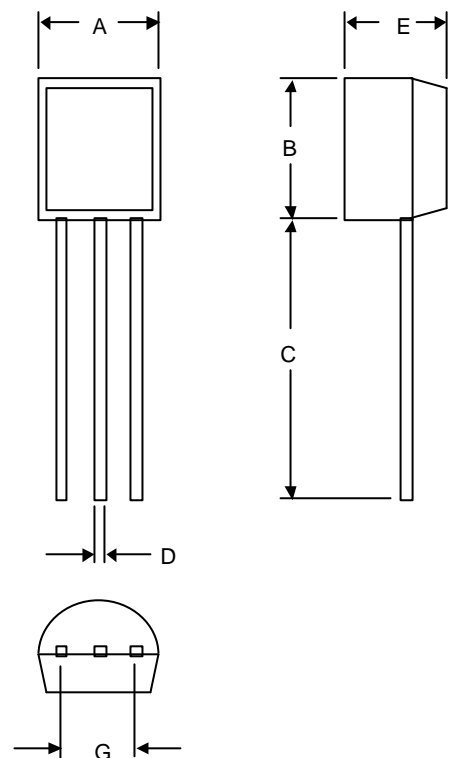

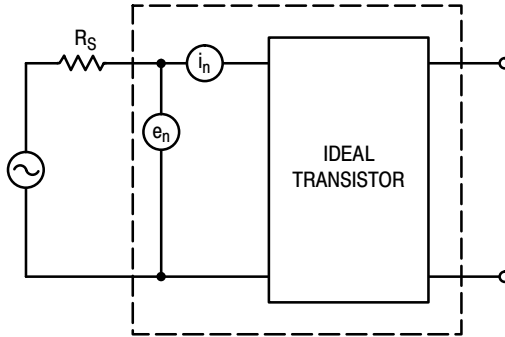


Figure 1. Transistor Noise Model

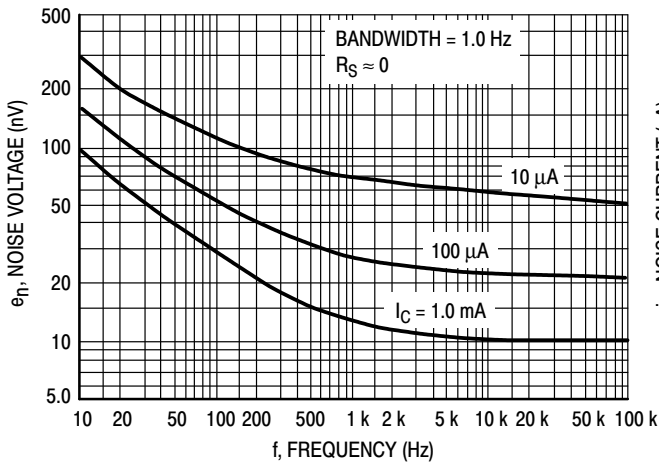


Figure 2. Noise Voltage

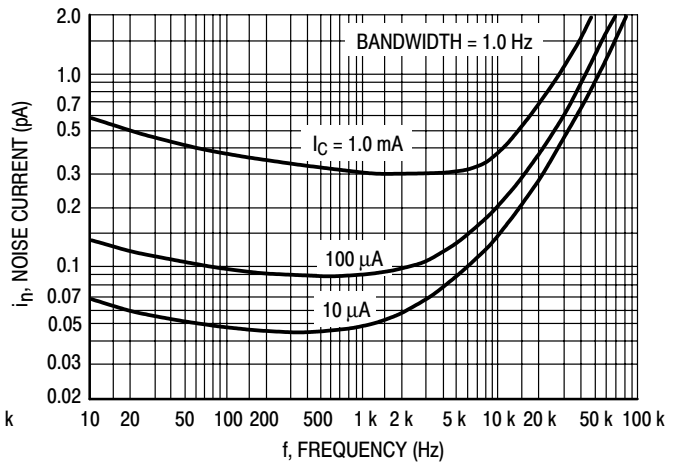


Figure 3. Noise Current

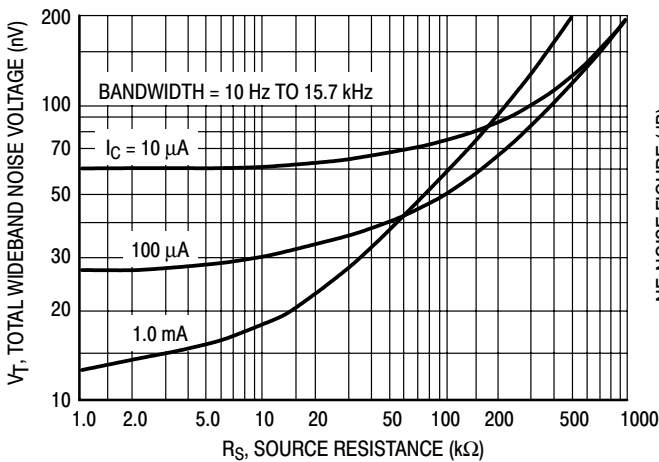


Figure 4. Total Wideband Noise Voltage

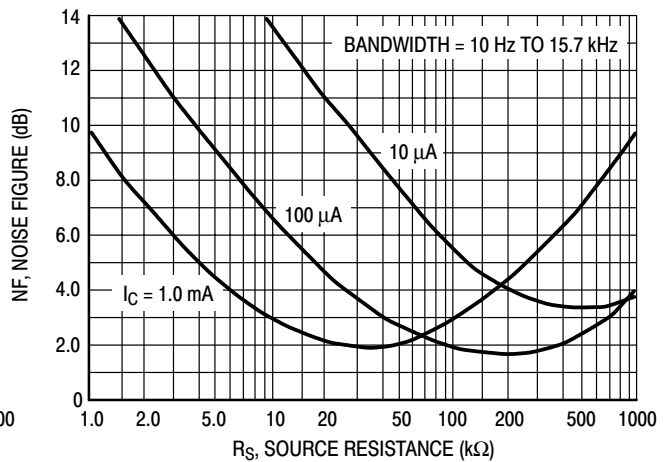


Figure 5. Wideband Noise Figure

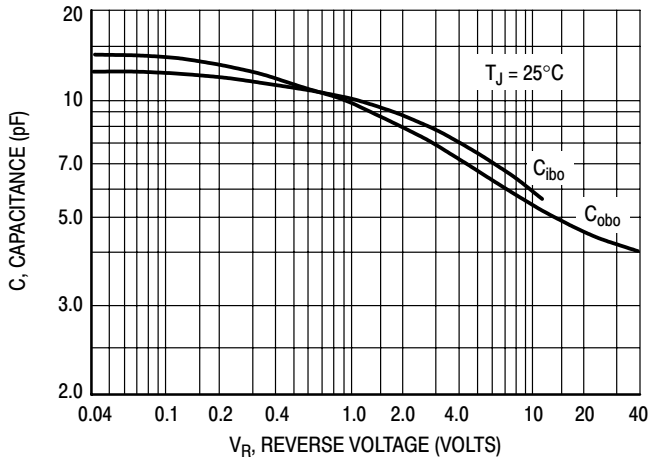


Figure 6. Capacitance

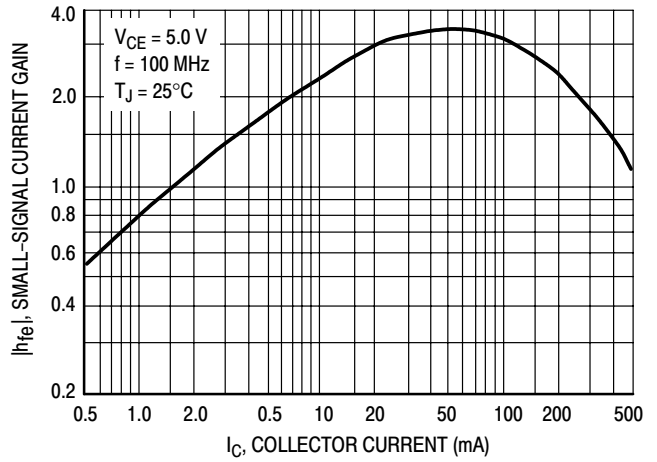


Figure 7. High Frequency Current Gain

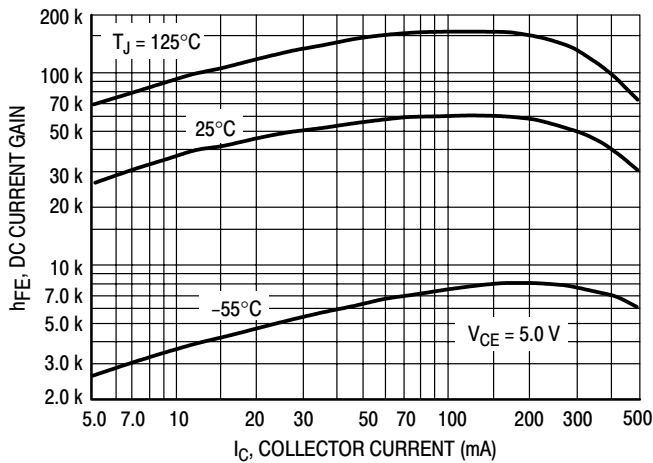


Figure 8. DC Current Gain

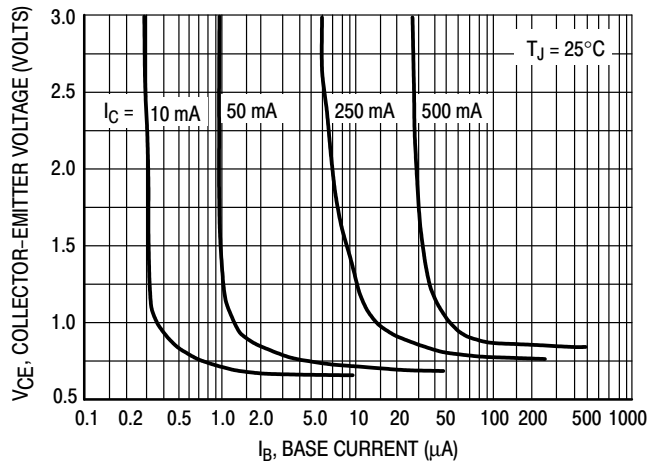


Figure 9. Collector Saturation Region

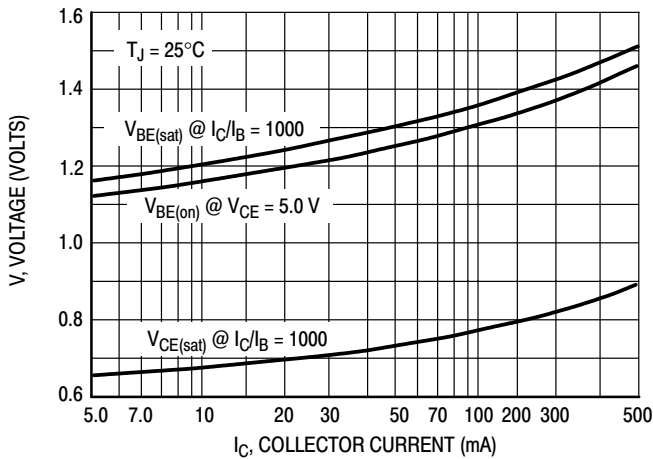


Figure 10. "On" Voltages

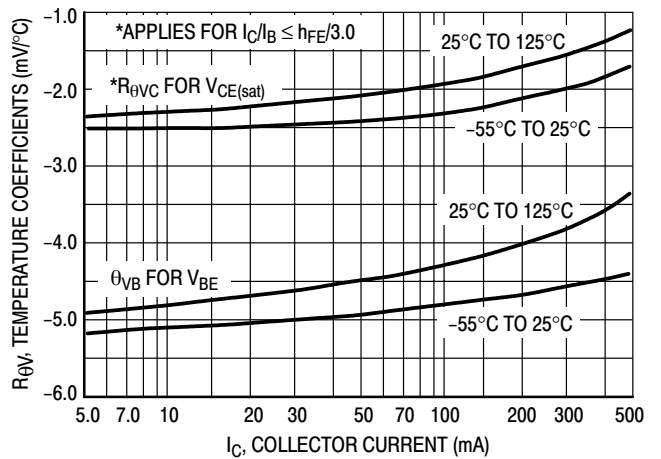


Figure 11. Temperature Coefficients

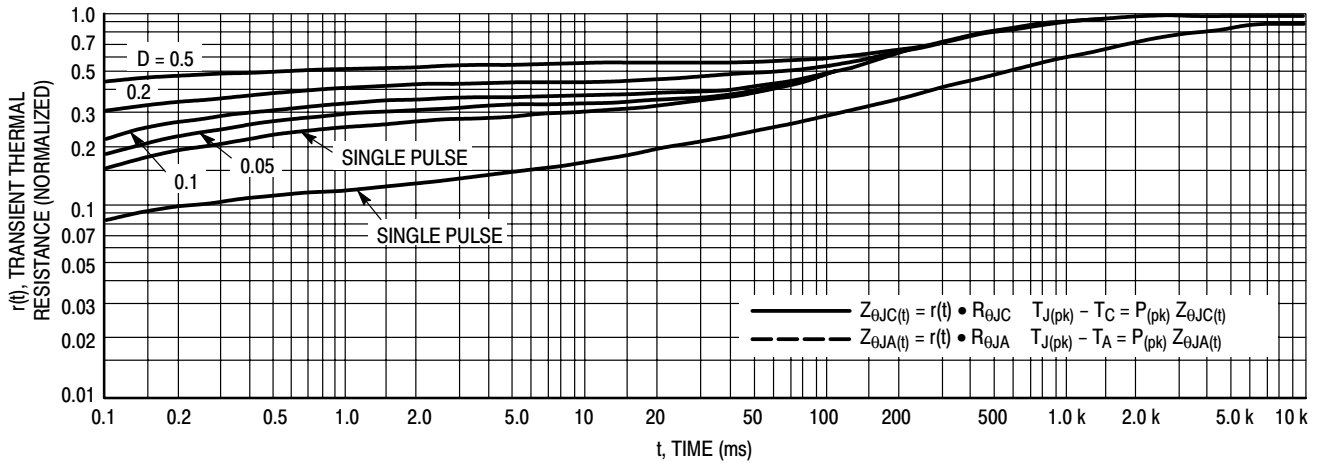


Figure 12. Thermal Response

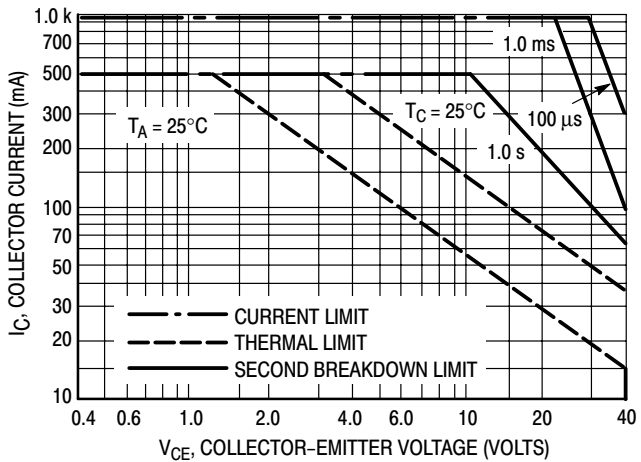
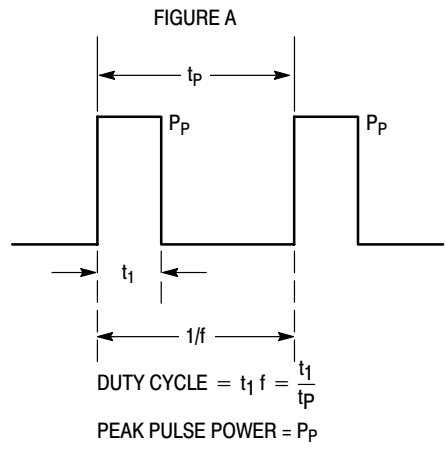


Figure 13. Active Region Safe Operating Area
