Functional Description


The CY62147EV30 is a high performance CMOS static RAM organized as 256K words by 16 bits. This device features advanced circuit design to provide ultra low active current. It is ideal for providing More Battery Life™ (MoBL®) in portable applications such as cellular telephones. The device also has an automatic power down feature that significantly reduces power consumption when addresses are not toggling. Placing the device into standby mode reduces power consumption by more than 99% when deselected (CE HIGH or both BLE and BHE are HIGH). The input and output pins (IO₀ through IO₁₅) are placed in a high impedance state when:

- Deselected (CE HIGH)
- Outputs are disabled (OE HIGH)
- Both Byte High Enable and Byte Low Enable are disabled (BHE, BLE HIGH)
- Write operation is active (CE LOW and WE LOW)

To write to the device, take Chip Enable (\overline{CE}) and Write Enable (WE) inputs LOW. If Byte Low Enable (BLE) is LOW, then data from IO pins (IO₀ through IO₇) is written into the location specified on the address pins (A₀ through A₁₇). If Byte High Enable (BHE) is LOW, then data from IO pins (IO₈ through IO₁₅) is written into the location specified on the address pins (A₀ through A_{17}).

To read from the device, take Chip Enable (CE) and Output Enable (OE) LOW while forcing the Write Enable (WE) HIGH. If Byte Low Enable (BLE) is LOW, then data from the memory location specified by the address pins appear on IO₀ to IO₇. If Byte High Enable (BHE) is LOW, then data from memory appears on IO₈ to IO₁₅. See the Truth Table on page 9 for a complete description of read and write modes.

For best practice recommendations, refer to the Cypress application note AN1064, SRAM System Guidelines.



BGA packaged device is offered in single CE and dual CE options. In this data sheet, for a dual CE device, $\overline{\text{CE}}$ refers to the internal logical combination of $\overline{\text{CE}}_1$ and $\overline{\text{CE}}_2$ such that when $\overline{\text{CE}}_1$ is LOW and $\overline{\text{CE}}_2$ is HIGH, $\overline{\text{CE}}$ is LOW. For all other cases $\overline{\text{CE}}$ is HIGH.

Figure 1. 48-Ball VFBGA (Single Chip Enable) [3, 4]




Figure 2. 48-Ball VFBGA (Dual Chip Enable)[3, 4]





Figure 3. 44-Pin TSOP II [3]



Figure 4. AC Test Load and Waveforms





Figure 6. Read Cycle No. 1 (Address Transition Controlled)[17, 18]





Figure 7. Read Cycle No. 2 (OE Controlled)[1, 18, 19]

Figure 8. Write Cycle No. 1 ($\overline{\text{WE}}$ Controlled)[1, 16, 20, 21]





Figure 9. Write Cycle No. 2 $(\overline{\text{CE}} \text{ Controlled})^{[1, 16, 20, 21]}$





Figure 11. Write Cycle No. 4 ($\overline{BHE}/\overline{BLE}$ Controlled, \overline{OE} LOW)[1, 21]




Figure 13. 44-Pin TSOP II, 51-85087
