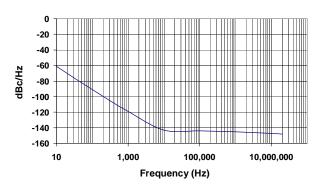

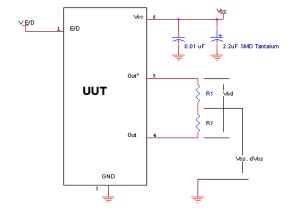

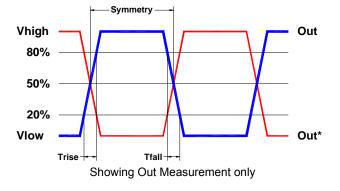
# **Typical Phase-Noise Response**

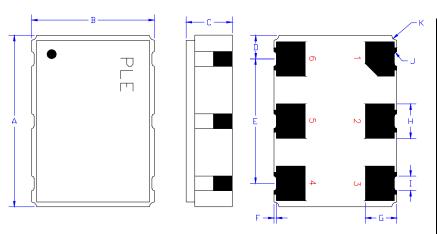

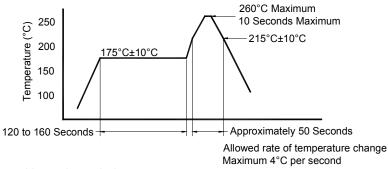
For Optimum Jitter Performance, Pletronics recommends:

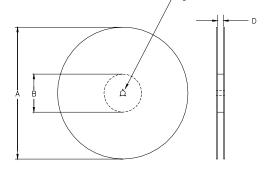

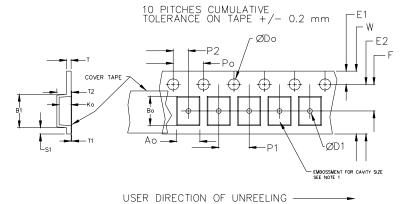
