




Forward Current vs. Relative Luminous Flux




Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage



Forward Current vs. Chromaticity Coordinate




Case Temperature vs. Chromaticity Coordinate



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
## Case Temperature vs. Forward Voltage




Case Temperature vs. Allowable Forward Current






