1. Product profile

1.1 General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a SOT404 plastic package intended for use in circuits where high static and dynamic dV/dt and high dl/dt can occur. This "series C" triac will commutate the full RMS current at the maximum rated junction temperature without the aid of a snubber.

- High commutation capability with maximum false trigger immunity

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




Fig 12. Package outline SOT404 (D2PAK)
