



Fig 1. Continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature








Forward transconductance as a function of










Fig 7. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values




 $T_{j}=25\,^{\circ}C; V_{DS}=5V$  Fig 9. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of

Fig 10. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature




Fig 11. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig 12. Gate charge waveform definitions




Fig 13. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values





Fig 14. Source (diode forward) current as a function of source-drain (diode forward) voltage; typical values




Fig 16. Package outline SOT873-1 (HVSON8)
