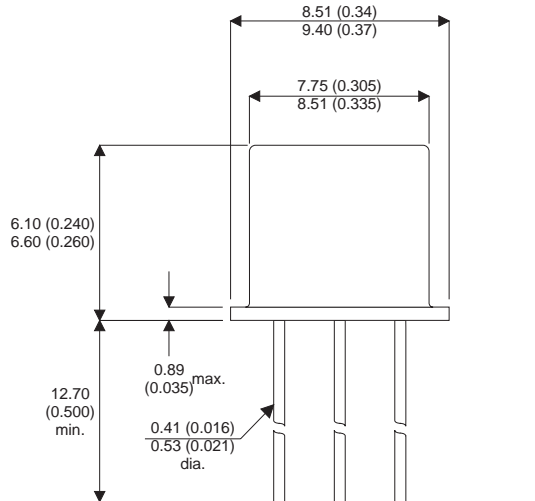

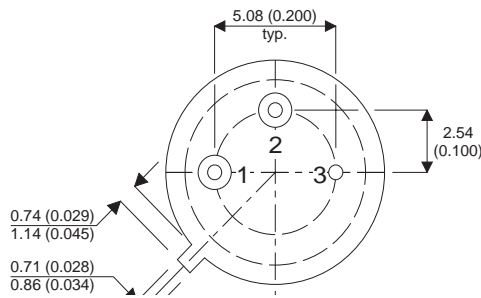

NOTES

- 3) Measured at a frequency where $|h_{fe}|$ is decreasing at approximately 6dB per octave.
