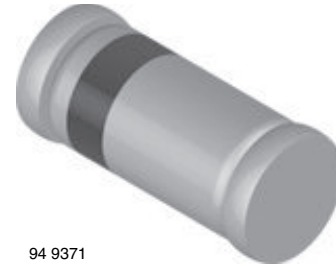
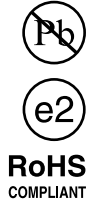

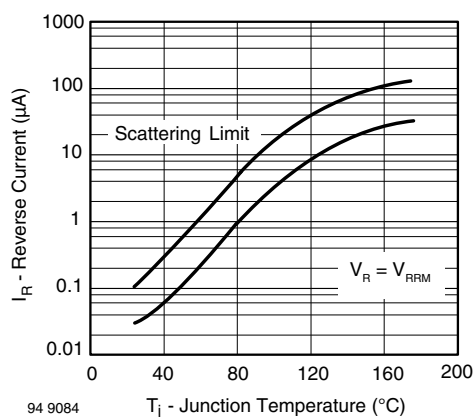


Figure 1. Reverse Current vs. Junction Temperature

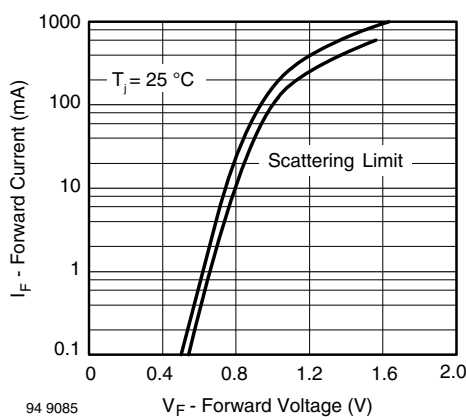


Figure 2. Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage

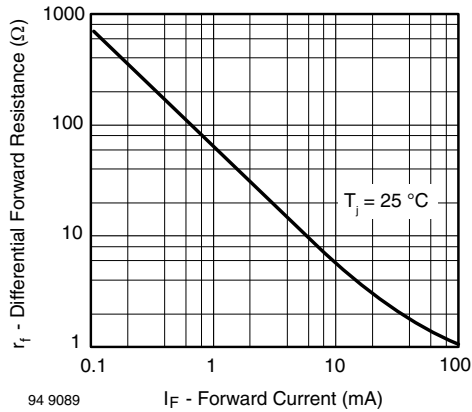
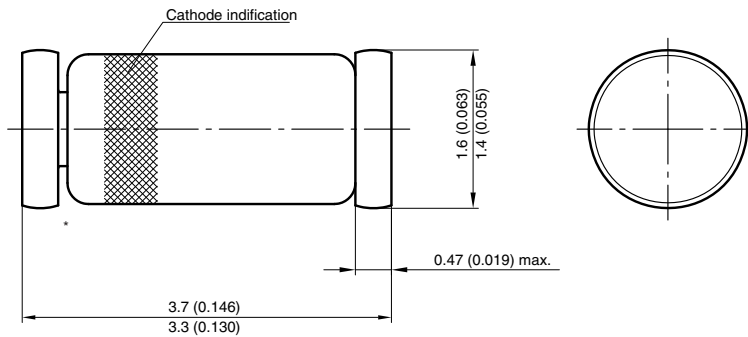


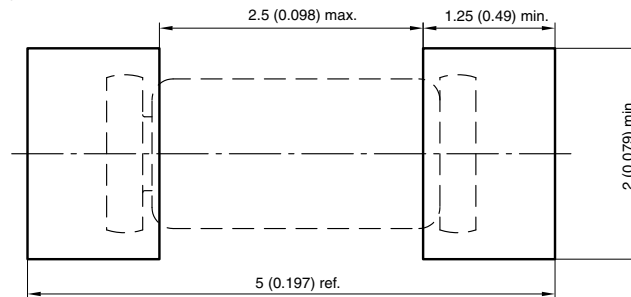
Figure 3. Differential Forward Resistance vs. Forward Current
