The VS-STPS1L30UPbF surface mount Schottky rectifie has been designed for applications requiring low forward drop and small foot prints on PC board. Typical applications are in disk drives, switching power supplies, converters, freewheeling diodes, battery charging, and reverse battery protection.

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


Fig. 1 - Maximum Forward Voltage Drop Characteristics




Fig. 2 - Typical Peak Reverse Current vs. Reverse Voltage






Fig. 3 - Typical Junction Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage




I_{F(AV)} - Average Forward Current (A)


