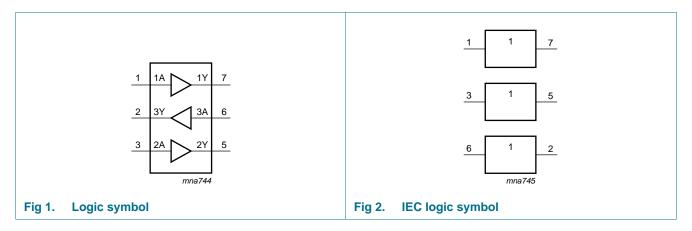

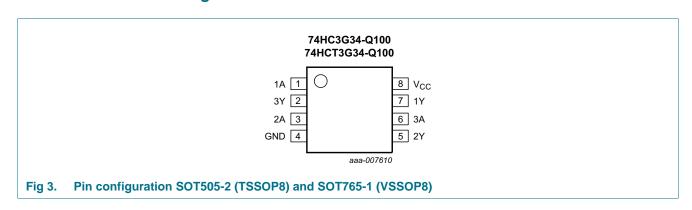

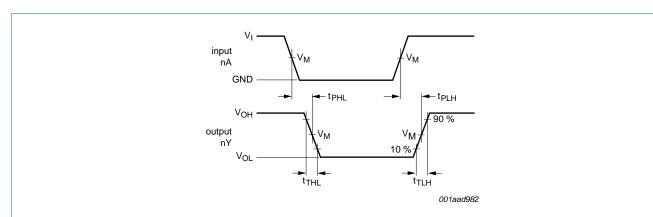

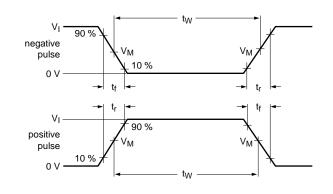


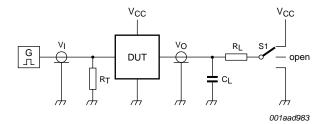

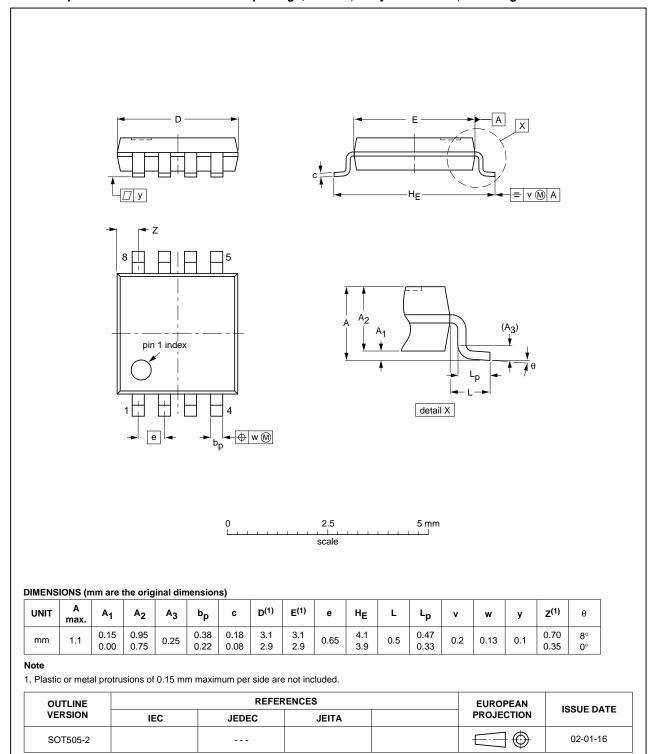
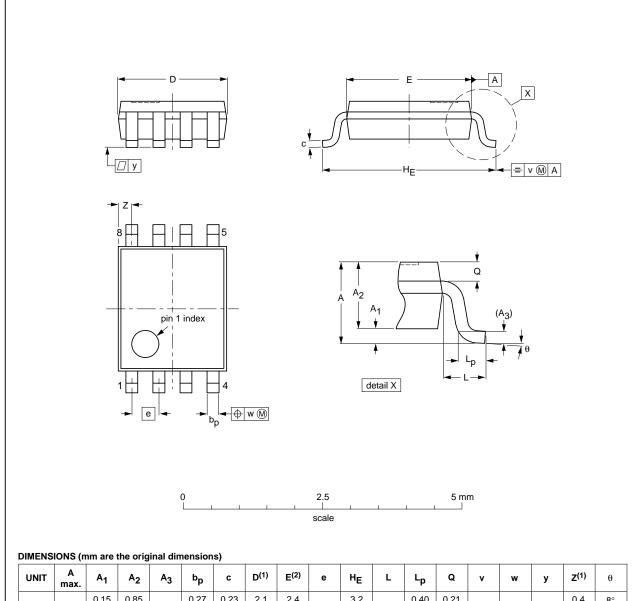


Fig 6. Package outline SOT505-2 (TSSOP8)
