
Description

NP29N06QDK is a dual N-channel MOS Field Effect Transistor designed for high current switching applications.

Features

- Super low on-state resistance
 - --- $R_{DS(on)1}$ = 20 mΩ MAX. (V_{GS} = 10 V, I_D = 15 A)
 - $R_{DS(on)2} = 30$ mΩ MAX. ($V_{GS} = 4.5$ V, $I_D = 7.5$ A)
- Low C_{iss} : $C_{iss} = 1000 \text{ pF TYP.} (V_{DS} = 25 \text{ V})$
- Designed for automotive application and AEC-Q101 qualified
- Small size package 8-pin HSON dual

Remark: Strong electric field, when exposed to this device, can cause destruction of the gate oxide and ultimately degrade the device operation. Steps must be taken to stop generation of static electricity as much as possible, and quickly dissipate it once, when it has occurred.




TEST CIRCUIT 2 SWITCHING TIME



TEST CIRCUIT 3 GATE CHARGE


Typical Characteristics $(T_A = 25^{\circ}C)$

DERATING FACTOR OF FORWARD BIAS SAFE OPERATING AREA




T_C - Case Temperature - °C

TOTAL POWER DISSIPATION vs. CASE TEMPERATURE





FORWARD BIAS SAFE OPERATING AREA





TRANSIENT THERMAL RESISTANCE vs. PULSE WIDTH





DRAIN CURRENT vs. DRAIN TO SOURCE VOLTAGE





GATE TO SOURCE THRESHOLD VOLTAGE vs. CHANNEL TEMPERATURE





DRAIN TO SOURCE ON-STATE RESISTANCE vs. DRAIN CURRENT





FORWARD TRANSFER CHARACTERISTICS




V_{GS} - Gate to Source Voltage - V

DRAIN TO SOURCE ON-STATE RESISTANCE vs. GATE TO SOURCE VOLTAGE











SWITCHING CHARACTERISTICS




I_D - Drain Current - A

DYNAMIC INPUT CHARACTERISTICS





 $V_{F(S-D)}$ - Source to Drain Voltage - V


REVERSE RECOVERY TIME vs. DRAIN CURRENT
