





3. Equivalent LC Model and Test Circuit




4. Typical Application Circuits





- 1. The center frequency, f_C , is measured at the minimum IL point with the resonator in the 50 Ω test system.
- Unless noted otherwise, case temperature T_C = +25°C±2°C.
 Frequency aging is the change in f_C with time and is specified at +65°C or less. Aging may exceed the specification for prolonged temperatures above +65°C. Typically, aging is greatest the first year after manufacture, decreasing in subsequent years.
- Turnover temperature, To, is the temperature of maximum (or turnover) frequency, fo. The nominal frequency at any case temperature, T_C , may be calculated from: $f = f_0 [1 - FTC (T_0 - T_C)^2]$.
- This equivalent RLC model approximates resonator performance near the resonant frequency and is provided for reference only. The capacitance C_0 is the measured static (nonmotional) capacitance between the two terminals. The measurement includes case parasitic capacitance.
- Derived mathematically from one or more of the following directly measured parameters: fc, IL, 3 dB bandwidth, f_C versus T_C, and C₀.
- The specifications of this device are based on the test circuit shown above and subject to change or obsolescence without notice.
- Typically, equipment utilizing this device requires emissions testing and government approval, which is the responsibility of the equipment manufacturer.
