



In addition, internal gate-source ESD diode allows UniFET II MOSFET to withstand over 2kV HBM surge stress. This device family is suitable for switching power converter applications such as power factor correction (PFC), flat panel display (FPD) TV power, ATX and electronic lamp ballasts.

Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs.
Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation vs. Source Current and Temperature





Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics

Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area vs. Case Temperature-FDPF3N50NZ




Figure 10. Maximum Drain Current




Figure 11. Unclamped Inductive Switching Capability







Figure 12. Transient Thermal Response Curve- FDPF3N50NZ




Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform




Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms





Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms







Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit & Waveforms
